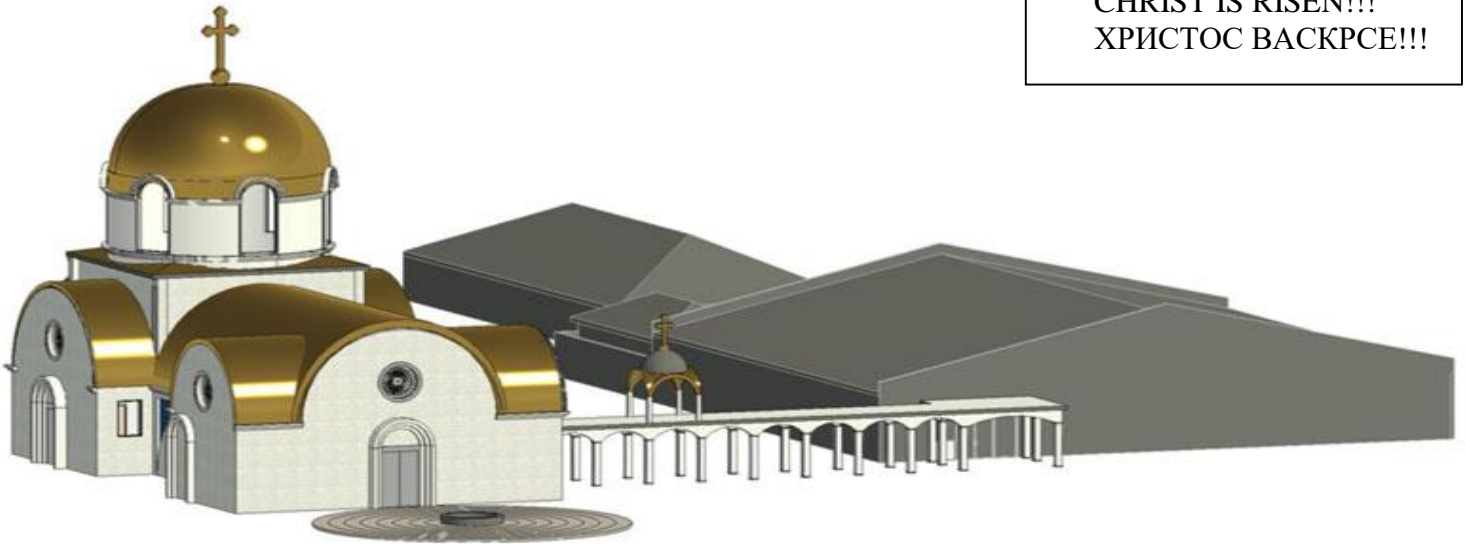

Building a Church NOT easy

Beloved in Christ,

Glory be to God and God's people, we have been one step ahead, every step of the way, in spite of so much detail and so many challenges! Of course, we have been preparing for this project for the past eighteen years by gathering all kinds of information from those who have already gone through the process, and we are still doing that (consulting with others).

We have been truly blessed by God sending specific and special people our way – from architects and general contractors to attorneys, donors, and people offering different kinds of expertise. Since we started working on the complete plans for the building, the prices for materials and the interest rates for borrowing money have gone up quite a bit. Even in this regard, we have anticipated and have been one step ahead. If we cannot complete the whole project at once, our goal is to build the church to the point of being able to get the certificate of occupancy and then finish other things in years to come. If there are things we cannot afford now (for example, the walkway from the existing building to the new church and marble floors), we will wait and do them later.

Securing a loan is not an easy task, but we have expanded our search to quite a few banks and organizations. Several people are working on this, searching locally and through the Internet, and they are looking into local banks, out-of-state banks, small banks, big banks, and religious and other lending organizations. We have even asked what might seem a silly question to the people and friends of our community to see if anyone out there would make a professional agreement with the church and lend us the necessary funds. In wanting to be always one step ahead, we recently started a second (and, we hope, final) fundraiser, asking all of our community's families and individuals (not including those of the first fundraiser, for whom we are VERY GRATEFUL) to promise to give monthly for the future mortgage payments. The response has been great (100+ families), and we are more than grateful! Between the two fundraisers we have about 220 households participating. Even more would be welcome and much appreciated! If you are able to help, please contact our priest at 317-374-3414. We do have a couple of backup plans, but, generally speaking, now it's in God's hands – as it has been from the beginning.

Out of all the general contractors with whom we have communicated, we have chosen two who have been most helpful to us during this process. We have sent out the plans for bidding, but at the same time we are weighing our options and trying to figure out whether a general

contractor (GC) or construction manager / superintendent (CM) would be best for us considering the circumstances. God willing, we should be making final decisions soon, and, if everything turns out well, we are looking to break ground in June of this year.

Let us pray to the Lord, and may God bless everyone involved in this process. YOU are truly wonderful and most awesome people of God!!!

Without a doubt, building a church is not easy, but it is a very blessed process because by it the Church also builds us – as a community, as Orthodox Christians, as friends of the parish, and so on.

Just as we ALL try to be in church for Christmas and Pascha/Easter, so we ALL need to make an effort to be there for this great and wonderful feast day, which always falls on SUNDAY, 50 days after Pascha. Just as we don’t fast on Wednesday and Friday after Christmas and Pascha, so we don’t fast after Pentecost.

Mobile soup kitchen!

We want you to know, but please not to share or put on social media that we have been feeding the homeless (in your name) of Indianapolis with first class hot soup during winter months. Our sisters prepare soup once a week and our priest, with one of the brothers puts it in the trunk of the SUV and drives around Indianapolis, stopping at every corner where there is a need - the trunk opens up, soup is poured in a big cup, spoon is placed inside, and some crackers are offered. We also bring: socks, hats, blankets, and bottled water. This is something no one else is doing, but we found it to be of great importance, because many of the homeless are mentally ill, and sometimes incapable to walk over to a soup kitchen. We go to them - we have been calling it: DoorDash for the homeless. Please pray for for this endeavor to continue and if interested in helping text message our priest.

FYI - We don’t want it to be shared because good deeds shouldn’t be publicized, unless they need to be for some good reason. Thank you.

CEMETERY INTEREST?

At our annual meeting, we voted on establishing a cemetery on our property. The cemetery would be at the back of the church property by the highway and the pond. We plan only to use 1 acre of our property which equals around 1000 plots. We are working on the details. The question for you is: would you be interested, and how many plots would you need?

PS We do plan on putting up a big stone cross at the cemetery where we would engrave names of our loved ones who have been buried elsewhere.

WILL & POWER OF ATTORNEW

First of all, please consider writing a will for the benefit of your family – we live in unique times, and this is very important. Please also consider giving someone you trust legal rights and special instructions over your health, God forbid you can't make decisions for yourself. Also, for the end of life decisions – these things are so important these days, no matter how old you are. At last please consider YOUR CHURCH in your Will.

MONTHLY MORTGAGE DONORS

These are the 100+ households which promised to give monthly for our mortgage payments for the new church. **Thank you. Thank you.** We are working on options on how to make this work. At this time following is what we figure: 1. bring donation to church and put in the vestibule box. 2. Direct transfer from bank to bank. 3. Donate through our website. 4. Mail the check.

You may give monthly or beginning (or end) of each year. The church will be in contact.

Thanks to you we ended up with several banks wanting to lend us the money for the building of our new church and we feel much more secure knowing that each month we will have \$7000+ dollars coming in for the mortgage payments which should be around \$14,000 a month (less or more) Thank you, thank you.

MILLION DOLLAR DONORS

These are the 100+ household who promised to give around \$10,000 in five years. **Thank you. Thank you.** The banks would not have even talk to us if we didn't have you on board – we showed them numbers, but not your names. When we get the loan, God willing, the banks will be following if that promise is coming in – please be timely on your donations – thank you. Also, the sooner you are able to fulfill the promise, the LESS interest the church will pay on the loan. Thank you. God bless you.

LEND US 2.5 MILLION

Before we sign any contract with the bank, we need to know if there is anyone out there who would be willing to lend the church \$2.5 million (or less) for the building of the new church at 5% interest for 25 years or until we pay off the loan, which we hope will be much sooner. Please forgive the question, but we would always rather pay interest to our people than the banks, and even the banks we are grateful for. A professional contract would be put together obviously.

TRUCK TRAILERS ON PROPERTY

In a couple of weeks, we will have around 10 truck trailers at the back of our property and they will stay there for several months and some of them until we finish building our church. We are doing this for three reasons. 1. Being a good neighbor Offering the back of our property to a neighboring hotel being renovated. 2. We will be using some of the trailers to store, expensive material, and tools during the building of our church. Please for your safety, stay away. Thank you.
